80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 11,12,13 and 14, with brass cap mkd.

80.08 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp., 35 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 7,12,13 and 18, heretofore described.

North 89\*45'W., on a true line bet. secs. 12 and 13.

Asc. 180 ft. over broken NE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

28.00 Spur, slopes N., desc. 150 ft. over SW. slope.

38.00 Head of ravine, course SW., thence over S. slope.

40.04 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
