	Soil; loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd. rate. Timber; fir, pine and cedar. Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

	From the cor. of secs. 2,3, 34 and 35, on S. bdy of Tp., previously described in field notes of T. 29 S., R. 2 E., this group. North 0*2'W., bet. secs. 34 and 35. Asc. 125 ft. over S. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.
4.00	Spur, slopes N.75*W., desc. 85 ft. over NW. slope.
6.70	Ravine, course NW., asc. 120 ft. over SW. slope to spur.
10.20	Grasshopper Trail, bears NW. and SE.
12.60	Spur, slopes NW., desc. 410 ft. over NE. slope.
20.30	Enter bottom land, bears E. and W.
22.30	Fish Lake Creek, 50 lks. wide, course N.80*W.
25.00	Leave bottom land, bears E. and S., asc. 560 ft. over SE. slope, to spur.
26.85	Trail, bears E. and W.
39.45	Spur, slopes SW., E. edge of rock knob, 20 ft. high, 20 ft. diam., desc. 25 ft. over face of sloping bluff.
40.00	Point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. falls on face of small bluff, facing NW., on which An exact cor. point, cut a cross (X) and $\frac{1}{4}$ to the W., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. from which: A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.20*E., 49 lks. dist. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 B T A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.59*W., 70 lks. dist. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 B T Desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
42.25	Same spur, slopes S. 25*E., asc. 245 ft. over SE. slope.
