56.10	Trail, bears NE. and SW.
64.10	Spur, slopes S., desc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.
65.40	Right Bank of Black Rock Fork of South Umpqua River, course S.75*W. from S.75*E., asc. 110 ft. over SE. slope to the sec. cor.
71.10	Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.
80.08	The cor. of secs. 10,11,14 and 15. Land, mountainous. Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd. rate. Timber, fir, pine, cedar, alder and maple. Undergrowth, vine maple and hazel.
16.00	North 0*2'W., bet. secs. 10 and 11. Asc. 530 ft. over SE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.
40.00	Spur, slopes SE., asc. 675 ft. over SE. slope. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
	from which: A pine, 42 ins. diam., bears N.43*E., 15 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S11 B T A pine, 40 ins. diam., bears S.43*W., 85 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T
44.00	Asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope. Spur, slopes SW., thence over rolling bench, on top of spur.
55.00	Leave spur, slopes S. from NW., desc. 345 ft. over NE. slope.
75.00	Head of ravine, course E., asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.
78.25	Spur, slopes E., desc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.
