67.50	Spur, slopes N., desc. 195 ft. along top of spur, slopes W.
80.48	The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22. Land, mountainous. Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd. rate. Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock. Undergrowth, rhododendron and chinquapin.
13.00	Trail, bears NE. and SW.
19.35	Left Bank of Black Rock Fork of South Umpqua River, course S.20*W.
21.35	Right Bank of Black Rock Fork of South Umpqua River, Asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.
