

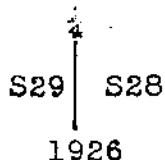
Subdivision of T.28 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS
79.86 The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd. rate.
Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock.
Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, manzanita and chinquapin.

North 0°3'W., bet. secs. 28 and 29.
Desc. 275 ft. over broken NW. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

23.50 Left Bank of South Umpqua River, course SW.
25.00 Right Bank of South Umpqua River.
Asc. 275 ft. over SE. slope to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

29.80 Trail, bears NE. and SW.
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

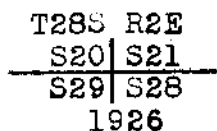

78.85 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 10 ft. over NE. slope.
80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29, with brass cap mkd.
