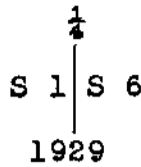


Township 28 South, Range 3 East.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N.26 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 38 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 6 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.22 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 48 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 1 B T.

Asc. slightly.

- 42.00 Spur, slopes E., desc. slightly to
 - 43.50 Trail, bears SE. and NW., desc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.
 - 47.65 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course SE., asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.
 - 55.25 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 85 ft. over NE. slope.
 - 62.85 Draw, drains SE., asc. 30 ft. over SE. slope.
 - 67.80 Spur, slopes E., desc. 20 ft. over NE. slope to
 - 78.11 Intersect the 6th Standard Parallel South, at the closing cor. of Ts. 28 S., Rs. 3 and 4 E., which bears West, 4.66 chs. dist. from the standard cor. of Ts. 27 S., Rs. 3 and 4 E., and is hereinbefore described.
- Land, mountainous.
Soil, gravelly and rocky, second rate.
Timber, fir, pine, and hemlock.
Undergrowth, willow, hazel, vine maple, small fir, and pine.
