N.0°02'W., bet. secs. 27 and 28.

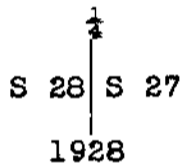
Desc. 15 ft. over NE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

6.30 Spur, slopes E., desc. 300 ft. over NE. slope to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

38.67 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.40°W., 14 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 B T.

Desc. 95 ft. over broken NE. slope.

52.45 Creek, 9 lks. wide, course NE., thence over E. slope.

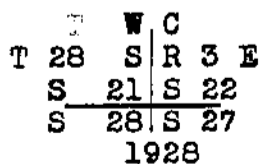
57.20 Way trail, bears E. and W., asc. 150 ft. over SE. slope.

58.86 Same trail, bears NE. and SW.

60.63 Same trail, bears SE. and W.

68.50 Spur, slopes E., desc. 240 ft. over NE. slope.

79.75 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for witness cor. to the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, with brass cap marked
