48.00 Trail to Acker's bears E. and W.

63.50 Divide bet. N. and S. Forks of South Umpqua river bears
NE. and SW.

Desc. along W. slope.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x14x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground
for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, mkd. with 1 notch
on S. and 5 notches on E. edge, from which,

Timber; fir, pine, cedar; undergrowth, arrow wood, fir.

East on a random line bet. secs. 29 and 32.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.36 Intersect N. and S. line 25 lks. N. of the cor. of secs.
28, 29, 32, and 33.

Thence I run

N.89*49*W., on a true line bet. secs. 29 and 32.

Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered
with dense undergrowth.
