Land; mountainous.

Soil; stony and shaly clay loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber; fir, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth; chinquapin, laurel, snowbrush, fir.

West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Descend 250 ft. on NW. slope.

- 11.85 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 250 ft. on W. slope.
- 18.20 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.; desc. 50 ft. on rolling N. slope, to
