54.00 Log house, South Umpqua Ranger Station, bears S., 2 chs. dist.

59.30 Fence, bears N. and S.; leave pasture.

75.00 Leave bench, bears N. and S.; asc. 80 ft. on E. slope, to

79.76 The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.

Land; mountainous and level.

Soil; on river bench, clay and alluvial loam, 1st rate; remainder, clay loam, stony in places, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, and pine.

Undergrowth; vine maple, hazel, chinquapin, fir.

N.0°02'W., bet. secs. 9 and 10.

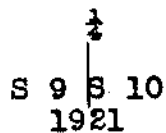
Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
