R. 1 W., and set closing cor., heretofore described.  
Land; mountainous and rolling.  
Soil; clay loam, stony in places, 2nd and 3rd rate.  
Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, and pine.  
Undergrowth; chinquapin, hazel, fir, vine maple.

From the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, heretofore described,

N.0\*04'W., bet. secs. 17 and 18.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Desc. 50 ft. on NE. slope.

5.00 Draw, course NE.; asc. 65 ft. on SE. slope.

13.75 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 345 ft. on N. slope.

32.00 Foot of descent, on river bottom, bears E. and W.

35.70 Left bank of South Umpqua River, 150 lks. wide, course W.

37.20 Right bank of river.

38.50 Trail, Tiller To Quartz Mountain and Grasshopper Ranger Stations, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

50.25 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 45 ft. on NE. slope.
