South Boundary of T. 29 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple and hazel.

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Descend 725 ft. over SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

43.10 Part of same stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend gradually along N. slope.
