## CHAINS

Undergrowth, Rhododendron, Chinquapin, Vine Maple, Yew and Dogwood.

S.89\*56'E., bet. Secs. 2 and 35.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 165 ft. over SW. slope.

- 8.25 Spur, slopes NW; continue along N. slope.
- 14.00 Dry gulch, C. N.60\*W; ascend 330 ft. over SW. slope.
- 19.50 Grasshopper Trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 24.00 Spur, slopes SW.
- 25.50 Same trail, bears S.75\*W. and N.75\*E.
- 31.40 Same trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 33.00 Top of ascent; spur, slopes NW. Descend 120 ft. over NE. slope to
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

- A Douglas Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.61\*W., 33 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 2 B T.
- Descend 10 ft. over NE. slope.
- 40.85 Dry gulch, C. NW; ascend 325 ft. over W. slope.
- 50.00 Spur, slopes N.30\*W; descend 240 ft. over E. slope.
- 56.63 Dry gulch, C. N; ascend 90 ft. over W. slope.
- 60.00 Spur, slopes N; descend 120 ft. over broken NE. slope.
- 67.50 Dry ravine, C. N.20\*W; ascend 350 ft. over broken W.
