

Subdivision of T. 29 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, chinquapin and vine maple.

N. 0* 1' W., bet. secs. 13 and 14.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 60 ft. over gradual S. slope.

- 8.00 Summit of spur, slopes, gradually W. Descend 100 ft. over N. slope.
- 14.83 Brook, 2 lks. wide, course W. Ascend 20 ft.
- 18.00 Low spur, slopes W. Descend 40 ft.
- 26.63 Brook, 3 lks. wide, course W. Continue over gradual NW. slope.
- 30.02 Brook, 1 link wide, course W.
- 32.17 Brook, 1 link wide, course W.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

- A white fir, 12 ins. dia., bears S. 89* E., 22 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 BT.
- A yew, 5 ins. dia., bears S. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ * W., 9 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 14 BT.
- Continue over gradual, rolling W. slope.
- 41.30 Draw, opens west.
- 59.33 Brook, 1 link wide, course N. 75* W.
- 72.00 A swale, opens W. No water. Ascend gradually.
- 75.85 Stock trail, bears E. and W. Enter old burn, same bearing.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, with brass cap marked
