

Subdivision of T. 29 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

A hemlock, 18 ins. dia., bears S.15 \* E., 40 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 E S 12 BT.

A hemlock, 8 ins. dia., bears S. 55 \* W., 21 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 E S 11 BT.

A white fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N. 64½ \* W., 37 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 E S 2 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky with clay loam; 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, hemlock and cedar.

Undergrowth, chinquapin, young forest trees, and vine maple.

S.89\* 51' E., on a random line, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

40.00 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.

80.30 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp., 14 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12.

Thence

N\*89\* 45' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Over mountainous land, through medium heavy timber and very dense undergrowth; in old burn.

Ascend 200 ft. over irregular, broken, E. slope.

20.00 Spur, slopes N. 30\* E., Descend 225 ft. over W. slope, to ¼ sec. cor.

26.36 Fish Lake Trail, bears N. 20\* E., and S. 20\* W.

31.50 Grasshopper Trail, bears S. 60\* E., and West.

32.45 Leave same, bearing N. 75\*W.

40.15 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

$$\frac{1/4 \text{ S } 1}{\text{S } 12}$$

from which

A white fir, 6 ins. dia., bears N. 34\* W., 44 lks. dist., marked ¼ S 1 BT.

A cedar, 12 ins. dia., bears S. 81 \* E., 26 lks. dist., marked ¼ S 12 BT.

Descend 320 ft. over W. slope.

50.00 Leave Buckeye Burn, bearing N. and S.
