Over mountainous land through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

Ascend 60 ft. over SE. slope.

11.49 Top of spur, and Acker Divide Trail, bear NE. and SW.

Descend 80 ft. over N. Slope.

23.25 Draw, opens NW. Ascend 75 ft.

27.00 Spur, slopes W. Descend 400 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

33.14 Top of bluff, 100 ft. high, facing N.

34.55 Foot of same; descend steep N. slope to

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23 with brass cap mkd.
