marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 BT.

A madrona, 12 ins. dia., bears N. 88* W., 8 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 BT.

Ascend 155 ft., over rocky SW. slope.

49.60 Spur, slopes W. Descend gradually.

51.60 Draw, opens W. Ascend 100 ft.

60.40 Spur, slopes SW. Descend gradually, over N. slope.

64.06 Brook, 3 lks. wide, course SW.

70.00 Ascend 90 ft., over SE. slope to

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky with clay loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, rhododendron and vine maple.

East on a random line, bet. secs. 28 and 33.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.14 Intersect N. and S. line, at the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33
and 34.

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 28 and 33.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and medium
