A madrona, 5 ins. dia., bears N. 51\*W., 15 lks. dist.,

marked T 29 S R 2 E S 30 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam and rocky; 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rate.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, fir, rhododendron and vine maple.

East, on a random line, bet. secs. 29 and 32.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.28 Intersect N. and S. line, 35 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

S. 89\* 45' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 29 and 32.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
