Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock and pine.

Undergrowth, huckleberry, vine maple, hard hack, small  
fir, and cedar.

N.89\*40'E., on a random line bet. secs. 20 and 29.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.80.18 Intersect N. and S. line 18 lks. N. of the cor. of secs.  
20,21,28 and 29.

Thence

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and medium  
S.89\*48'W., on a true line. (undergrowth.)

Desc. 35 ft. over W. slope.

2.50 Draw, drains SW., asc. 45 ft. over SE. slope.

10.70 Spur, slopes S., desc. 155 ft. over W. slope.

20.00 Middle of E. shore of a round pond.

26.45 W. shore of the pond, asc., 10 ft. over NE. slope.

27.00 Low spur, slopes S., desc. 45 ft. over W. slope.

37.50 Draw, wet springy ground, drains SW., asc. 15 ft. over  
SE. slope to40.09 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 28 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked
$$\frac{1}{4} \begin{array}{l} S 20 \\ S 29 \\ 1927 \end{array}$$
