	A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.71*E., 28 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 8 B T.
	A Pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S.79*W., 19 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T.
	Descend 260 ft. over NW slope.
69.00	Enter a meadow, bears N and S. Scattering large timber.
75.00	Foot of desc. on N slope; asc. 20 ft. over NE slope to Sec. corner.
79.00	Enter medium timber, bears N and S.
80.38	The corner of Secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd rate. Timber, Fir, Pine, Cedar and Larch. Undergrowth, Vinemaple, Huckleberry, small Fir, Yew and Alder.
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	S.89*49'W., on a random line bet. Secs. 7 and 18.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.
82.26	Intersect W bdy. of Tp. 16 lks. N of the corner of Secs. 7 and 18 only. Thence N.89*42'E., on a true line. Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and light undergrowth. Ascend slightly over rocky N slope to
20.00	Foot of cliff. 650 ft. high, bears N and SW.
22.40	Top of cliff; thence over rolling land, descend 55 ft. over NE slope.
34.25	Draw, drains NE; asc. 20 ft. over NW slope to $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.
39.90	Forest Service Trail, bears NE and SW.
42.26	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, to bed rock, in a mound of stone, 4 ft.
