

Subdivision of T. 29 S., R. 3 E.

CHAINS

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

Descend 105 ft. over SW. slope.

11.08 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground at mean high water line of Fish Lake, for meander corner with brass cap marked

A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.6°E., 60 lks.

dist., marked T 29 S R 3 E S 5 M C B T.

A Cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears N.3°W., 24 lks.

dist., marked T 29 S R 3 E S 6 M C B T.

Thence across the lake, distance determined by meanders of E. shore, as hereinafter given.

40.56 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for meander corner at mean high water line on S. shore of Fish Lake, with brass cap marked

An Alder, 7 ins. diam., bears S.76°E., 29½ lks.

dist., marked T 29 S R 3 E S 5 M C B T.

An Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears N.55°W., 72 lks.

dist., marked T 29 S R 3 E S 6 M C B T.

Thence over swampy land, through medium timber and dense undergrowth.

45.25 Ascend 500 ft. over broken N. slope.

60.77 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NE.

76.95 Spur, slopes NW; descend 15 ft. over SW. slope.

78.25 Draw, drains NW; ascend 20 ft. over NW. slope to

79.39 The corner of Secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8 at S. edge of dense undergrowth.

Land, mostly mountainous.

Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky; 3rd rate.
