dist., mkd. T 29 S R 5 E S 19 B T.

A Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 63* W., 46 lks.
dist., mkd. T 29 S R 4 E S 24 B T.

A Fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 1* W., 48 lks.
dist., mkd. T 29 S R 4 E S 13 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky, 2nd to 4th rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and pine.

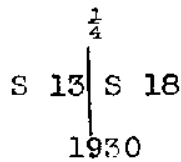
Undergrowth, small fir, hemlock, and pine.

North, bet. secs. 13 and 18.

Asc. 200 ft. over rocky SW. slope, through medium
timber and medium undergrowth.

7.35 Spur, bears W.; leave the rock, desc. 240 ft. over
NW. slope.

26.00 Foot of desc. on W. slope; asc. 65 ft. over SW. slope to
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 28 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 64* W., 36 lks.
dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.

Asc. 90 ft. over SW. slope.

60.00 Enter open grass land, bears NE. and W.

62.00 Trail, bears E. and W.

64.00 Top of asc. on W. slope; thence over W. slope

72.00 Leave grass land; enter small timber, bears E. and W.
