40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 58* W., 36 lks. dist., mkd. T 29 S R 4 E S 23 B T.
