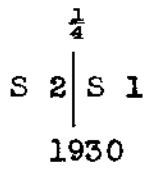

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 87* E., 22 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 29* W., 8 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B T.

Desc. 130 ft. over S. and SE. slopes.

43.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains SE.

51.25 Wash, drains SW.; thence over W. slope.

60.85 Minnehaha Creek, 12 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 140 ft. over NW. slope to sec. cor.

65.73 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course NW.

71.45 Bend of same creek, 3 lks. wide, course from SE. to NE.

80.31 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky, 2nd to 4th rate.

Timber, fir, pine, hemlock, and larch.

Undergrowth, willow, alder, small fir, pine, and hemlock.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, on the S. bay of the township, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 30 S., R. 4 E. N. 0*02'., bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Asc. 20 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and light undergrowth.

16.00 Spur, bears SW.; desc. 55 ft. over NW. slope.

25.20 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 60 ft. over S. slope to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
