Timber, fir, pine, hemlock, and larch.

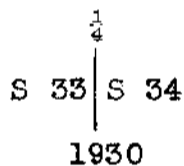
Undergrowth, mountain laurel, small fir, pine, and hemlock.

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From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on S. bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 30 S., R. 4 E. N. 0°02' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Desc. 65 ft. over rolling NW. slope to  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., through medium timber and medium undergrowth.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ \* E., 48 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 34 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 55\* W., 5 lks. Dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 33 B T.

Thence over level land.

61.80 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.

65.50 Spur, bears W.; desc. 15 ft. over NW. slope.
