- 39.87 Left bank of Rogue River, 62 lks. wide, course SW.
- 39.89 Point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. in the river.
- 40.55 Leave river; thence over nearly level land.
- 48.00 Asc. 85 ft. over SE. slope, enter heavy timber, bears
NE. and SW.
- 65.40 Trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 75.50 Spur, bears S.; desc. 80 ft. over W. slope.
- 78.13 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 45 ft. over E.
slope to
- 79.78 The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16.
Land, mountainous and rolling.
Soil, sandy and gravelly loam and rocky, 2nd to 4th rate.
Timber, fir, pine, hemlock, larch.
Undergrowth, willow, mountain laurel, small fir, pine,

Asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and
