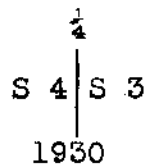
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

South, on a true line.

Desc. 60 ft. over rolling SE. slope, through small timber and dense undergrowth to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

- 3.55 The N. end of a road; thence along the E. side of road.
- 37.50 Same road, bears SE. and NW.
- 40.19 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked.
