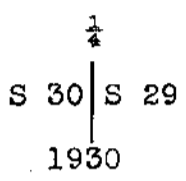


Township 29 South, Range 4 East.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked.

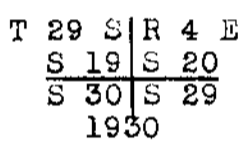

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 80\* E., 46 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 29 B T.

A pine, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 57\* W., 36 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 30 B T.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29, and 30, with brass cap marked



from which,

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 9\* E., 104 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 4 E S 20 B T.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 16\* E., 45 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 4 E S 29 B T.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ \* W., 50 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 4 E S 30 B T.

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 76\* W., 24 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 4 E S 19 B T.

Land; rolling.

Soil; sandy and gravelly loam, 2nd rate.

Timber; fir, pine, and hemlock.

Undergrowth; mountain laurel, chinquapin, small fir, pine, and hemlock.
