80.00 Set a conglomerate stone, 18x12x6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for cor. of Secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, marked with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edge, from which

A Pine, 28 ins. diam., bears N.76*E., 14 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 1 E S 35 B T.

A Pine, 36 ins. diam., bears S.57*E., 41 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 1 E S 2 B T.

A Madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears S.56*W., 46 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 1 E S 3 B T.

A Fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N.85*W., 50 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 1 E S 34 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay and stony, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Pine and Cedar.

Undergrowth, Hazel, Fir and Madrone.
