A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.1*W., 35 lks. dist.

Marked T 30 S R 1 W S 24 A P B T: old B. T.

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N.6*W., 62 lks. dist.

Marked T 30 S R 1 W S 13 B T: new B. T.

I obliterate marks on former bearing tree intended
in the original survey to refer to sec. 18,
T. 30 S., R. 1 E.

The bearing and length of this half mile is S.1*43'E.,
40.29 chs.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, stony clay loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, pine.

Undergrowth, hazel, arrow wood, lilac, vine maple.

S.83*07'E., retracing connecting line. N. bdy. sec. 24.

1.40 Draw, course NW., ascend 93 ft. over W. slope.

4.62 Spur, slopes NW., descend E. slope 143 ft.

21.75 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. Ascend 100 ft. over NW.
slope.

28.49 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.

29.53 Intersect the Willamette Meridian at the cor. of sec.
13 and 24 only.

The bearing and length of this line is S.83*07'E.,
29.53 chs.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, stony, third and fourth rate.

Timber, fir and cedar.

Undergrowth, hazel, fir.
