52.36	Spur, slopes S., descend 60 ft.
58.30	Leave opening, bears N. and S.
59.55	Dry gulch, course S., ascend 410 ft. over steep, rocky NE. slope.
70.65	Spur, slopes SW., descend 180 ft. over W. slope to sec. cor.
78.00	Enter opening, bears N. and S.
80.16	The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. Land, mountainous. Soil, clay loam and stony, second and third rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar. Undergrowth, chinquapin, hazel, and vine maple.
