CHAINS

A Fir, (new) 12 ins. diam., bears S.28°E., 163 lks. dist., mkd. T 31 S R 3 E S 5 B T.

A Fir, (orig.) 28 ins. diam., bears S.70°45'W., 114 lks. dist., mkd. T 31 S R 3 E S 6 B T.

A Fir, (orig.) 26 ins. diam., bears N.82½°W., 58 lks. dist., mkd. T 30 S R 3 E S 31 B T.

The bearing tree N. of line now refers to the cor. of Secs. 31 and 32 only.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Pine, Hemlock and Cedar.

Undergrowth, Yew, Hazel, and Huckleberry.

S.89°16'W., bet. Secs. 6 and 31.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and light undergrowth.

Asc. 270 ft. over NE. slope.

13.50 Golden Stair Trail, bears S. and NW.

14.60 Rock spur, slopes S.; asc. 20 ft. over S. slope.

20.00 Rocky spur, slopes S.; desc. 430 ft. over W. slope, leave heavy timber, bears N. and S., enter dense undergrowth.

31.15 Gulch, drains SW., asc. 20 ft. over E. slope.

34.00 Spur, slopes S., desc. 95 ft. over W. slope.

39.59 Point 40.00 chs. in Westing from SE. cor. of Sec. 31.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor. of Sec. 31 only, with brass cap mkd.
