- A fir, 16 ins. dia., bears S. 55\*W., 87 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{2}$  S 24 W C B T.
- Thence over rolling land.
- 46.18 Forest Service Trail, bears N. and S.
- 58.60 Leave timber; enter a swamp and dense undergrowth, bears  
NW. and SE.; asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.
- 72.35 Leave the swamp and enter heavy timber, bears N. and S.
- 78.00 Top of asc.; desc. slightly over SW. slope to sec. cor.
- 79.00 Leave timber, enter a swamp and dense undergrowth, bears  
NW. and S.
- 79.96 The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24.  
Land, rolling and rolling mountainous.  
Soil, sandy, gravelly, peat, and volcanic ash, 1st and  
2nd rate.  
Timber, fir, pine, hemlock, and cedar.  
Undergrowth, willow, hazel, small pine and fir.
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- N.0\*01'W., bet. secs. 13 and 14.  
Over rolling mountainous land, through scattering  
timber and dense undergrowth.  
Asc. slightly in a swamp.
- 1.75 Edge of the swamp and a trail, bears E. and W.; asc.  
145 ft. over S. slope.
- 12.00 Top of asc.; thence over rolling land.
- 18.25 Wire fence of a Beaver Farm, bears SW. and NE.
- 21.00 Desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.
- 24.40 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course SW.; thence across bend of  
the creek.
- 25.15 Leave the creek; asc. 60 ft. over SW. slope.
- 33.90 Top of asc. and wire fence of the Beaver Farm, bears  
NW. and SE.; desc. slightly over NE. slope to
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 30 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
