Over mountainous land, through heavy timber, leave dense undergrowth.

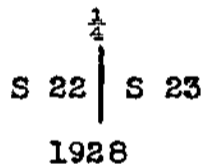
Asc. 230 ft. over SW. slope.

10.00 Leave heavy timber, bears E. and W.; enter very dense undergrowth.

22.00 Spur ridge, bears NW. and SE.; leave dense undergrowth and enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW., desc. 245 ft. over NE. slope to  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

27.15 A dim blazed trail, bears SE. and NW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 32 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A Fir, 16 ins. dia., bears S.5°E., 14 lks. dist. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 23 B T.

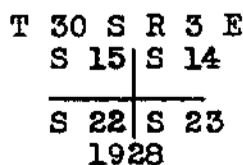
A Fir, 22 ins. dia., bears N.63 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 63 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 22 B T.

Desc. 260 ft. over NE. slope.

57.00 Wash, 5 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 335 ft. over SE. and S. slopes to sec. cor.

66.00 Anderson Camp trail, bears E. and W.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 18 ins. in the ground, to bed rock, and build a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 1 ft. high, around the post, for cor. of Secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, with brass cap mkd.
