Undergrowth, chinquapin, snow brush, huckleberry, hazel,
small fir and pine.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

79.76 Intersect N. and S. line 35 lks. N. of the cor. of
Secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.

Thence

N.89*58'W., on a true line.

Over nearly level swamp, through dense undergrowth.

3.20 Leave the swamp and enter medium timber and light
undergrowth, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 60 ft. over
SE. slope.

10.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 65 ft. over SW. slope, leave
timber and enter dense undergrowth, bears N. and SE.

17.15 Forest Service trail, bears SE. and NW.

17.20 Wire fence, bears NW. and SE.

18.50 Brown's Cabin Creek, 6 lks. wide, Course S.; asc.
130 ft. over broken SE. slope.

20.44 Wire fence, bears N. and S.

20.70 Anderson Camp trail, bears N. and S.

33.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.
