Asc. 795 ft. over NE. slope.

85.03 Ridge, bears N. and S. and intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp. at the closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, which bears N.0\*13'E., 4.01 chs. dist., from the cor. of secs. 13 and 24 only, and is hereinbefore described.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, gravelly, and rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar, and hemlock.

Undergrowth, vine maple, chinquapin, hazel, huckleberry, small fir, and pine.
