14.60 Cliff, nearly perpendicular, 75 ft. high, bears N. and SE.  
23.40 Falcon Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N.; enter dense under-  
growth, asc. 475 ft. over E. slope to  
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the

76.54 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 300 ft. over E. slope

85.10 Intersect W. bdy. of the Tp. at the closing cor. of secs.  
7 and 18, which bears N.0\*13'E., 4.03 chs.
