Soil, sandy, and rocky, 3rd and 4th rate.  
Timber, Fir, Pine and Cedar.  
Undergrowth, snow brush, vines, weeds, grass, small fir, pine and hemlock.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The surface of this Township is mostly mountainous, there is considerable level and gently rolling land, in the South Eastern part, and some high rolling land in the Northern part.

The soil in the Eastern part is volcanic ash or contains much of that substance. The soil in the rest of the Township is sandy and gravelly, with some loam. The bed rock of lava and sandstone outcrops in many places.

Most of the drainage is into the Rogue River, which flows through the Eastern part of the Township. About 5 sections in the Northwestern corner drain into the Umpqua River.

About half of the area is covered with a good stand
