of Fir and Pine timber. There is about the area of a section of good grazing land. The rest of the area is old burns, mostly covered with dense undergrowth. There are no known valuable minerals. Grazing probably is the only profitable pursuit. There is a beaver farm in Secs. 14 and 23, and a muskrat farm in Sec. 23. There are several excellent camp grounds and two small summer cottages. The Crater Lake Highway and the Diamond Lake Road, cross the SE. part of the Township. The average magnetic declination is 21*30' East.
