

South Boundary of T. 29 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam and rocky; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, and cedar.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple, and hazel.

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Descend 725 ft. over SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
$$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} \text{ S } 35 \\ \frac{1}{4} \text{ S } 2 \\ 1923 \end{array}$$

from which,

A maple, 22 ins. in dia., bears N.16*W., 27 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 B TA fir, 30 ins. in dia., bears S.43*E., 39 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B T

Descend 50 ft. to

42.05 Right bank of Abbott Creek, course NW.

42.40 Left bank of same creek, same course.

43.10 Part of same stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend gradually along N. slope.

60.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 9 ins. in dia., bears S.75*W., 27 lks. dist.,
