A black oak, 24 ins. diam., bears S.84*E., 102 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 1 E S 1 B T.

A yellow pine, 38 ins. diam., bears S.13*W., 74 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 1 E S 2 B T.

A black oak, 24 ins. diam., bears N.24*W., 62 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 35 B T.

Land, high and mountainous.

Soil, 2nd rate.

Covered with dense forests of fir, yellow and sugar pine, black and white oak. 80.00 chs.

Thick undergrowth of fir, matheron, yew, black and white oak, dogwood and chinquapin.

2.50 Enter glade, bears N. and S.

3.55 Trail to Abbott Prairie bears N. and S.

6.15 Dog Gulch, course S.

10.50 Leave glade, bears N. and S.

20.25 Ravine courses S. at a point about 200 ft. below sec. cor. and ascend.

40.00 A point about 300 ft. above ravine and set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 S. on N. face; from which

A black oak 7 ins. diam., bears S.54*E., 51 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.37*W., 68 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S B T.

41.50 Top of ridge bears N. and S. at a point about 30 ft. at above 1/4 sec. cor.

Descend about 700 ft. to,
