45.75 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, runs NE.

78.50 Creek, 4 lks. wide, runs NE.

80.00 Set a fir post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, marked T 31 S S 32 on NE., R 1 E S 5 on SE., T 32 S S 6 on SW., and S 31 on NW. faces, with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edges, from which,

A dogwood, 4 ins. diam., bears N.55*E., 28 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 32 B T.

A yew, 8 ins. diam., bears S.3*E., 73 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 1 E S 5 B T.

A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears S.46*W., 51 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 1 E S 6 B T.

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears E.3*W., 4 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 31 B T.

Land, high and mountainous.
