40.00 Set a fir stake, 3½ ins. sq. and 4 ft. long, 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on W. face, from which,

A red fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.66*E., 25 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

A red fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.75*W., 38 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

80.00 Set a stone, 14x10x10, 9 ins. in the ground, for cor. to Tps. 30 and 31 S., Rgs. 1 and 2 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, from which,

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N.57*W., 7 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 1 E S 36 B T.

A red fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.61*W., 28 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 1 B T.

A red fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.32*E., 16 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 2 E S 31 B T.

A white fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.39*E., 57 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 2 E S 6 B T.
