Retracement and Dependent Resurvey of Willamette Meridian through T. 31 S., As Surveyed by Fred Mensch, U. S. Cadastral Engineer, Under Special Instructions, dated June 7, 1922.

CHAINS

Retracement

I commence at the cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 S., R. 1 E., only, which is a basalt stone, firmly set, 6x14x6 ins., above ground, marked with 6 notches on N., S., E., and W. edges; from which

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.10*E., 58 lks. dist., marked W M T 31 S R 1 E S 31 B T. (Old BT.)

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S.47*E., 63 lks. dist., marked W M T 32 S R 1 E S 6 B T. (Old BT.)

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S.81*W., 78 lks. dist., marked W M T 32 S R 1 W S 1 B T. (Old B T.)

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.32*W., 23 lks. dist., marked W M T 31 S R 1 W S 36 B T. (Old BT.)

I obliterate the marks on the bearing trees referring to Tps. 31 and 32 S., R. 1 W., and re-mark the stone 31 S on N., 32 S on S., and 1 E. on E. face.

Thence

North, retracing W. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Asc. 890 ft. to closing cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 S., R. 1 W., over S. slope.

- 0.76 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.
- 25.33 California-Oregon Power Co. road, bears E. and W.
- 25.43 Trail, bears E. and W.
- 25.88 California-Oregon Power Co. transmission line, bears E. and W.
- 27.03 California-Oregon Power Co. telephone line, bears E. and W.
- 30.38 Fall 49 lks. E. of the closing cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 S., R. 1 W.
The bearing and length of this line is N.0*56'W., 30.38 chs.
