CHAINS

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.24*E., 25 lks. dist.,
marked T 32 S R 1 E S 5 B T (New B.T.)

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S.53*W., 51 lks.
dist., which I re-mark T 32 S R 1 E S 6 B T
(Old B.T.)

The old bearing trees N. of line are dead and the
old SE. tree is not found.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, stony clay loam, 3rd and 4th rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, and pine.

Undergrowth, hazel, live oak, laurel, and manzanita.

S.88*03'W., on N. bdy. of sec. 6.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

Ascend 915 ft. on SE. slope.
