A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.70*E., 34 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 27 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.79*W., 29 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 28 B T.

A chinquapin, 10 ins. diam., bears N.39*W., 16 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 21 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam and rocky, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, and cedar, mostly young growth and scattering.

Undergrowth, hazel, madrona, chinquapin, vine maple and fir.

N.0*02'W., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 520 ft. on SW. slope.

15.50 Spur, slopes SE.; descend 50 ft.

19.41 Ravine, course NE.; ascend 40 ft., to

21.35 Summit of spur, bears NW. and SE.; descend 120 ft. along NE. slope to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

26.57 Trail, bears NW. and SE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
