marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 B T.

Ascend 230 ft. on SE. slope.

42.00 Trail, bears E. and W.

59.00 Spur, slopes SW.; continue along broken W. slope.

66.66 Trail, bears NE. and SW.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, with
brass cap marked

A cedar, 34 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 74 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 1 E S 21 B T.

A cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears N.49*W., 18 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 1 E S 16 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, southern part, rocky, 3rd and 4th rate; balance,
clay loam, 1st and 2nd rate.

Timber, southern part, scattering; northern part, scat-
tering clumps of fir, pine, and cedar.

Undergrowth, snowbrush, madrona, hazel, manzanita, vine
maple, and fir.
