43.80 Spur, slopes W.; descend 45 ft.

Enter dead timber, bears E. and W.

53.75 Dry ravine, course SW.; ascend 350 ft. to

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28, and 29, with brass cap marked

A pine stub, 25 ft. high, 48 ins. diam., bears N.35 W., 40 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 1 E S 20 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam and rocky, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, and cedar.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple, hazel, and madrona.

East, on a random line, bet. secs. 21 and 28.

40.00 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.

79.80 Intersect N. and S. line, 14 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.
