- 65.79 Spur, slopes NW.; descend 75 ft. to
- 68.13 Brook, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; ascend 230 ft. over NE. slope.
- 75.82 Spur, slopes NE.; descend 60 ft. over NW. slope to
- 77.96 Trail, bears NE. and SW.
