

Subdivisions of T. 31 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

Descend 325 ft. over NW. slope.

11.00 Enter old burn, bears NE. and SW.

14.90 Brook, 3 lks. wide, course NE.

21.04 Brook, 1 lk. wide, course NE.; ascend 180 ft. over SW. slope, to

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.60*E., 194 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 20 B T.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.18*W., 132 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 B T.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. is located on spur, sloping E.; descend abruptly 100 ft. over NW. slope.

42.60 Dry ravine, course NE.; ascend gradually along NE. slope. Enter green timber, bears NE. and SW.

67.18 Trail and telephone line, bears NE. and SW.

72.03 Divide bet. Umpqua and Rogue Rivers, bears NE. and SW.; a trail follows this divide.

Descend 75 ft. over NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20, with brass cap marked
